- Proposing and completing a student stewardship project using the MWEE framework
- Communicating with CGLL and Sea Grant staff within the mentor/mentee model

### Dates/times:

This educator professional development program is tentatively set for January-July 2022 with both live and on-demand sessions, and concludes via a summit with educators from across the Great Lakes region. All classes and the summit will be held virtually on dates and times convenient for enrolled participants. Expected time commitment is estimated to be 2 hours per week which includes time for both class content, teamwork, and out of class time assignments. The finalized agenda will be announced by mid-December 2021.
